Dear Parishioners

This weekend at all of the Masses we are having our special collection for the people of Haiti. It is our way of supporting them at this terrible time. We pray for the faithful departed and for the all those who are suffering in an already poor country. I have been very impressed by the faith of the people in the face of such a tragedy. It is a lesson to us all. I am sure it will remind us of the precious gift of life and our family and friends. Things that can be taken in an instance. As mentioned we will match your giving today from parish reserves, so that what you give will be doubled in value. If you are a gift aider you may want to put your donation in an envelope with your gift aid number and we can reclaim the tax. This is the number on the bottom left hand side of your gift aid envelope. If you are not sure of your gift aid number then please see me about it. We welcome a student for the priesthood John Paul Lyttle. He will be living in the presbytery for the next few months and will be working on various projects in the parish.

He is a good musician so at least we hope he can improve our singing. No easy task !! He is very welcome in the parish and I know you will make him feel at home. I will let you know the areas of work that he will be involved in over the next weeks as he settles in. He has been visiting the schools and will spend half days in each of our schools each week supporting our teachers and helping with Music. He will also be helping with the parish music groups and will be starting a Youth Choir at the 12noon Mass on Feb 7th. If you are interested in joining then let us know. It will be good fun and any of our young people are welcome to be involved. This weekend we have our next stage on the journey for First Holy Communion. The children will be presented with Bibles and the theme of the Mass will be the Word of God. Bibles will be presented to the children at the 9am Mass at Christ the King and the 10.30am Mass at St Augustine's. We are beginning to put in place arrangements for our World Youth Day Visit to Madrid

in 2011. We will be booking a hostel in Madrid for the Papal Mass and looking at other sites associated with St Teresa of Avila, St John of the Cross and St Thomas Aquinas. It promises to be an exciting trip. If you are 16 years old by July 2011 you can come on the trip. We will be having an information evening with youth and their parents at the beginning of February. Have a think about it and if you haven't already signed up please let us know. We are looking to arrange a parish pilgrimage to Lisbon and Fatima in October 2010 and there is a list at the back of Church to see how many might be interested in such a trip. If there is enough interest then we will arrange it. I would use Janet Keefe of Vapour Trails who organised our excellent pilgrimage to Rome. We would stay in the Carmelite Hotel as we did in Rome. Signing the list is not a commitment to come but gives an idea of numbers. Membership for the club will be renewed to ensure that members have first options on things like New Year tickets, World Cup events and family evenings. We will also have members' events to reward members for their support. Membership is £2 for Pensioners, £3 for Pensioner Couples, £4 for an individual and £5 for a family which includes any children under 18. Membership is for one year. Membership cards will be available from from this weekend, from the club and later in the month after Sunday Masses in the Library.

We are looking to update our newsletter over the next month or so with a new version by Easter. We would like the new edition to have more information about the parish, schools and the community and sports centre. It will have larger print. It will have sections of news and teaching about of faith, saints for the week, parish updates, finance and management etc. If you would like to be part of the planning group then let us know, a note email or call will do and we will arrange a meeting in the near future.
